CHAT[™] (Comprehensive Health Assessment for Teens) is a behavioral health assessment tool designed for use with **clients ages 13-18**.

CHAT assessment results can help guide treatment planning for adolescents who are beginning or are already in treatment for substance abuse or mental health problems, or who have entered into the juvenile justice system or a youth treatment facility.

Modeled on the adult ASI-MV Connect, CHAT includes sections on Psychological Health and Relationships as well as Substance Use. It has three important features lacking in other adolescent assessment instruments:

- ▶ **Follows** a developmental approach that emphasizes the varying needs of young people
- ▶ **Presents** Resiliency factors and strengths as well as problem areas, to provide a more comprehensive portrait for guiding treatment
- ▶ **Uses** engaging multimedia to facilitate adolescents' self-administration

As part of the ASI-MV Connect system, CHAT gives you a cost-effective way to:

Track progress and outcomes – Using the Data Center, you can access "real time" aggregate data about clients and monitor changes and trends over time.

Enhance client-treatment matching – The data from the self-administered assessment are extracted and organized in clinical reports designed to assist you in making the optimal treatment and placement decisions.

Facilitate quality assurance – Using a standardized assessment tool makes it easier for service providers and managed care organizations to measure the efficacy of programs.

CHAT, developed and research-tested with funding from the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA), has been found to be both a reliable and valid assessment tool.
